	<b>Diwali (Deepavali)</b> 08 November, Sunday	Diwali 2026, the Festival of Lights, celebrates victory of light over darkness. Homes are decorated with diyas, sweets, and fireworks across India with joy and devotion.
	<b>Govardhan Puja / Deepavali Holiday</b> 09 November, Monday	Govardhan Puja 2026 honors Lord Krishna lifting Govardhan Hill. Devotees prepare Annakut food offerings and celebrate nature, gratitude, and divine protection.
	<b>Bhai Dooj</b> 10 November, Tuesday	Bhai Dooj 2026 celebrates the bond between brothers and sisters. Sisters pray for their brother's long life and prosperity, strengthening family love and traditions.
	<b>Remembrance Day / Veterans Day</b> 11 November, Wednesday	Remembrance Day 2026 honors fallen soldiers and veterans. People observe silence and ceremonies to respect those who served and sacrificed for their nations.
	<b>Singles' Day</b> 11 November, Wednesday	Singles' Day 2026 is a global celebration of self-love and independence, widely known for massive online shopping sales and discounts across e-commerce platforms.
	<b>Children's Day / Nehru Jayanti</b> 14 November, Saturday	Children's Day 2026 celebrates the birth anniversary of Jawaharlal Nehru, honoring children's rights, education, and joyful activities across schools in India.
	<b>Chhath Puja (Main Day)</b> 15 November, Sunday	Chhath Puja 2026 is a sacred festival dedicated to Sun God, observed with fasting, river rituals, and prayers for health, prosperity, and family well-being.
	<b>Tulsi Vivah</b> 21 November, Saturday	Tulsi Vivah 2026 marks the symbolic marriage of Tulsi plant with Lord Vishnu, signaling the start of the Hindu wedding season with rituals and devotion.
	<b>Guru Nanak Jayanti (Gazetted Holiday)</b> 24 November, Tuesday	Guru Nanak Jayanti 2026 celebrates the birth of Guru Nanak Dev Ji with prayers, kirtan, and langar, spreading messages of equality and spirituality.

	<b>Paush Purnima</b> 03 January, Saturday	Paush Purnima 2026 is a sacred Hindu full moon day observed with holy river bathing, charity, and prayers. It marks spiritual cleansing and the beginning of the auspicious Magh month rituals.
	<b>Shattila Ekadashi</b> 14 January, Wednesday	Shattila Ekadashi 2026 is a sacred Hindu fasting day dedicated to Lord Vishnu, observed with sesame-based rituals, prayers, and charity to cleanse sins and bring peace, prosperity, and spiritual growth.
	<b>Maagha Amavasya</b> 18 January, Sunday	Mauni Amavasya 2026, observed during the sacred Magha month, is a significant Hindu day for silence, holy river bathing, and spiritual purification, bringing peace, blessings, and inner growth.
	<b>Jaya Ekadashi</b> 29 January, Thursday	Jaya Ekadashi 2026 is a sacred Hindu fasting day dedicated to Lord Vishnu, observed for spiritual purification, removal of past sins, and attaining peace, prosperity, and divine blessings.
